CASA of McKean County has been supporting children in McKean County since 2014. CASA (Court Appointed Special Advocates) are appointed by a judge to advocate for a child's best interests. CASA volunteer advocates will stay with each case until it is closed and the child is in a safe, permanent home. CASA volunteer advocates work with families, legal and child welfare professionals, educators and service providers to ensure that a judge will have all the information they need to make the most well-informed decisions for each child. We serve children from birth through 21, the age defined by Pennsylvania state statute as the limit for remaining in care. For many of the children we serve, their advocate will be the one constant in an otherwise chaotic life.

Our Work

Through best-interest advocacy, our program and volunteers make a life-changing difference for McKean County's most vulnerable children.

Having a caring adult advocate for their best interest can make a lasting difference for a child who's been neglected or abused.



Brighter Futures and Stronger Communities

Children who have experienced abuse or neglect fare better with a CASA volunteer by their side. Studies have shown: They are more likely to find a safe, permanent home. They are more likely to succeed in school. They are half as likely to re-enter the foster care system.
